

## **Museum Guidelines to School/Other Groups**

Thank you for your interest in visiting our museum, National Museum of Nature and Science.

To protect precious collections/specimens and facilities, so all may enjoy it, we ask that all visitors including School and other group follow these guidelines and to review them with all your group before your visit. (A Museum manner video called “KAHAKU NO OKITE (Six Museum Rules)” is available on our website. Please also check and review it as well.)

We require the Leader/Teacher and/or chaperons to accompany their groups at all the time and to pay attention to the conduct of all their groups.

**Any school/other group not following the guidelines will be asked to leave the Museum.**

- 1. Please keep silence in the Museum - no running, no yelling, no speaking loudly.**
- 2. Many of the Museum’s specimens and artifacts throughout the Museum are not to be touched. Do not climb on or play with any exhibits other than hands on. Help us protect by respect precious collections.**
- 3. Be careful when using the escalators. It is dangerous for yourself and others around you if you don’t ride the escalators in an orderly fashion.**
- 4. Eating and drinking is not allowed except in certain places such as the Lounge\*, restaurant and any benches around the building or on the rooftop\*\* of Global Gallery.**  
**\*Lounge is located in the basement floor of Japan Gallery**  
**\*\*Rooftop will be closed according to the weather**
- 5. Taking group photo in the Museum is not allowed especially in exhibition halls or in front of the Lounge.**
- 6. Give priority to wheelchair users, stroller users, the handicapped and the elderly when using the elevators.**
